MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER

Commissioner Naas called the meeting to order

2. DETERMINATION OF QUORUM

3. NEW BUSINESS

A. Approve Minutes from Mar. 12th

The March 12th minutes were unanimously approved.

4. OLD BUSINESS

A. <u>Discuss Ranking Criteria for Transportation Projects</u>

The members reviewed and revised the ranking criteria definitions and scoring spectrum.

B. Create Ranking Criteria for Development Impacts

The members discussed the following for the Development Impact Process (DIP):

• TAB can study the existing road corridors to determine what existing capacity is and what it will be with a pending TIP project(s) (corridor capacity snapshot). Then, TAB will be able to react to proposed development.

The following are considerations:

- Utilize NCDOT AADT map
- o Utilize generally accepted capacity thresholds
- o Establish a range for how much capacity remains (high, medium, low)
- Break corridors up into sections that are intuitive and per the available traffic counts
- Vacant lot map
- Mr. Grant conveyed that the Town Attorney has stated that the Town Board cannot consider the TAB's opinions/recommendations/feedback to make development decisions. The Town Board can make traffic related decisions with the development's TIA only.
- TAB to aspire to review projects at the PDRC level.
